

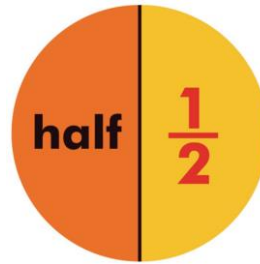
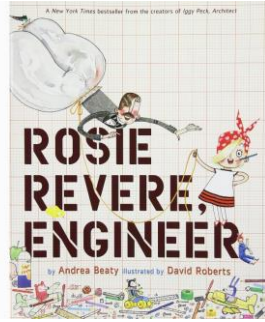


# Coral Class - WB 10.1.22



## English

We have looked at the story 'Rosie Revere, Engineer' this week and have written a character description about Rosie. We've expanded on our use of adjectives with the power of 3- using three adjectives to describe one thing. We also used similes and conjunctions, and we tried to vary our sentence starters rather than using 'she has' and 'she is.'



## Maths

In Maths this week we have focused on fractions. We learned that fractions means equal parts of a whole. We have looked at halves and know that this means 2 equal parts. The children have found different ways to halve shapes and have begun to find halves of amounts.

## Science
