

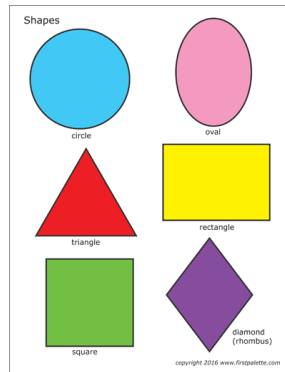


# Coral Class - WB 24.1.22



## English

Once upon a time, Year 2 wrote their own traditional tales! We have looked at lots of different traditional tales and picked out key elements they have. We focused in on the story of the three little pigs and wrote our own version called the three little engineers! The children changed the materials used to build the houses and made up their own villain character.



## Maths

We have focused on shapes this week. The children have really impressed us with their recognition of both 2D and 3D shapes, and describing their properties. They went on to use lolly sticks to make 2D shapes, and toothpicks and blue tac to make 3D shapes. We will continue to look at shapes next week.

## Science

This week we went around the school and picked out different objects. The children then identified the materials which the objects were made from. We discussed why that material had been used based on its properties.

## DT

For DT this week we have started to think about healthy eating. The children explored different food packages and identified where the nutritional information was. We then compared each item's sugar content with the daily recommended allowance for children and found some shocking results!



## Phonics

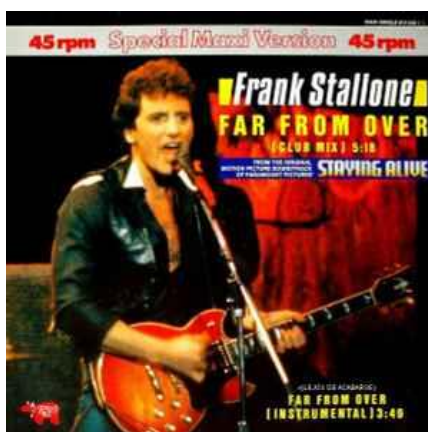
This week we have been recapping consonant suffixes: -ly, -ment, -ful, -ness, -less
