

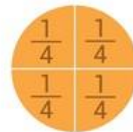
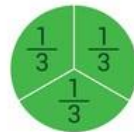
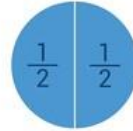


# Ruby Class - WB 17.1.22



## English

This week we looked at the poem 'I am building... something' and decided to create our own poems out building. We looked at the poem and spotted loads of adjectives. We also noticed that the end of each line rhymed. We spent some time brainstorming different rhyming words we could use, and then put these into our poem with our own adjectives.



## Maths

In Maths this week we have continued our work on fractions. The children know that quarters are 4 equal parts and thirds are 3 equal parts. They used their knowledge of finding half last week, to find quarters and thirds of shapes and amounts this week.

## Science

We have built on our knowledge of materials and their properties this week by carrying out an experiment on how material can be manipulated. The children tested different materials to see if they could bend, squash, stretch, or twist.

## Art

In our art lesson we applied the drawing skills we have learned to create some observational drawings of buildings and structures around Norwich. The children looked for the shapes in their subject and shaded using different methods.

## Phonics

This week we have been looking at the 'l' sound at the end of the word using le, el, al, and il.
