### Phonics

**Our Sounds this week were:** wh (w), ph (f), ey (ee), au (or)

**Our Words this week were:** you, my, said, was, with

**Spellings and words for next week:** all, so, made, time, there

**English...** This week in English we have been looking at how to construct a sentence ensuring that the punctuation is correct. We have used a mysterious picture to write about and thinking about how to make the sentence successful. As a class we have thought about how to make the writing more interesting by using adjectives, different sentence openers and challenging ourselves to use different conjunctions not just and.



**Maths...** In Maths this week we have started to look at height. We began by creating and looking at all the different vocabulary that goes with height and ensuring we use the mathematical language: tall, taller, tallest, similar, short, shorter, shortest, the same. We then moved our learning onto looking at measuring how tall something is by using non-standard units (such as beads, cubes etc.) and then being able to prove which one is the tallest. We ensured that when we are measuring height we are always starting at the same point to ensure it is fair and precise.



**RE...** In RE this week we have continued our learning of Judaism. We started our lesson with the question 'What is the meaning of Moses?' and discussed who Moses could be. We found out that Moses is a leader. We then discussed what a good leader is and why we need a good leader. The children then drew a picture of someone who is their leader and wrote about why they are a good leader. Within RE this term we will be discussing the story of Moses and Passover.
