Phonics

Our Sounds this week were: ir (girl), oy (boy) and ue (glue and rescue)

Maths... In our Maths this week we have been looking at division. We introduced the division (÷) symbol and explained that this is like sharing. We had a go at working out the questions concretely (using resources) and pictorially (drawing it out). We spoke about how the first number is how many objects you begin with and the second number in the number sentence is the number that you are sharing it by.
