

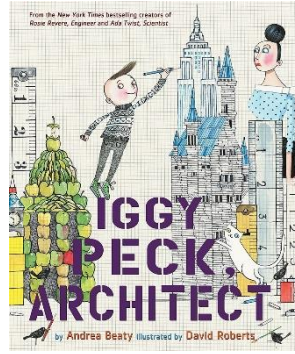


Ruby Class - WB 21.2.22



English

This got our engineering brains working and the children have been designing bridges and writing a set of instructions for making one. They chose from suspension, arch, beam and cantilever bridges.



Maths
