Tues 15th March and Wed 16th March – Parent/Carer Evenings

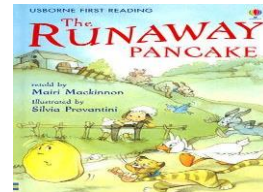

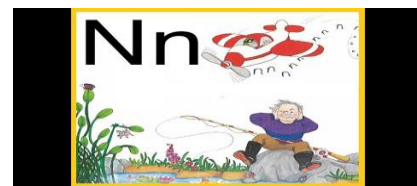
