**English...** This week we have been busy generating and writing some simile sentences using the words like/as. We have challenged ourselves by including adjectives into our sentences and also tried to remember to check our writing for any Marvellous Mistakes.

Maths... This week we have been learning all about capacity or volume. It has been lots of fun exploring different containers and how much water they hold. We have predicted how many cups it would take to fill a variety of containers and also used our problem solving skills to solve our weekly challenges. The children have shown a great understanding of what empty, full, nearly full/empty, half full/empty and overflowing is. **Computing**... This week we have learnt about algorithms and how they are like a set of instructions. We worked with a partner and built structures with Lego. It was important to listen to our partner's instructions carefully so we could achieve our Lego structure. If we noticed a problem then we had to debug (delete the problem) and

start again.


