English... This week in English we have been writing a book review about 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. We have focused on including conjunctions (but, so, or, and, because) into our verbal and written sentences to make them longer and more detailed by playing lots of games. The children wrote in the first person to explained their views and opinions about the book and also gave it a star rating.



Maths... This week we have been busy learning about weight. We brainstormed lots of vocabulary that we would use to describe different weights, used scales, measured the weight of objects using non-standard units (NSU's) and made estimations/predictions about how many NSU's it would take to make our scales balanced when an object was in 1 side.



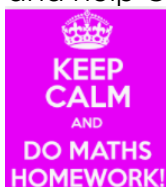
