



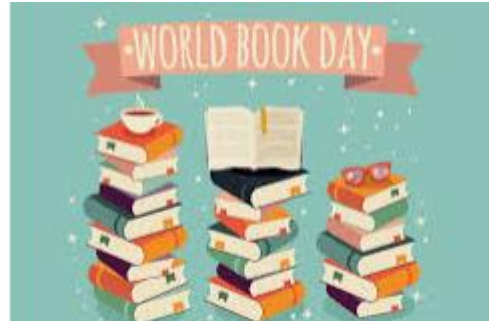

## World Book Day and book week

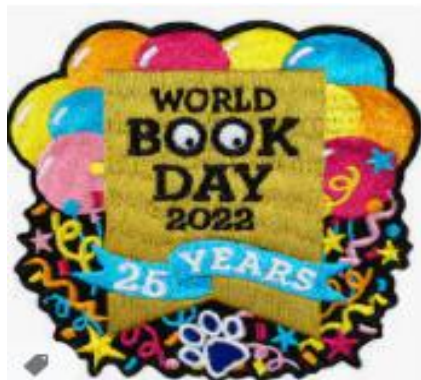
