


Ruby Class - WB 28.2.22



English

This week we have been reading the story Iggy Peck, Architect. The children have been adapting the story of Iggy Peck into their own versions, creating a character who saves the day. The children have also been using some of the language from the story to create their own stories on World Book Day.





Maths

We have been telling the time this week to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to the hour. The children have really impressed us with their knowledge of telling the time. Please see if you can continue to help their understanding at home by asking them questions.

Science

This week we have been looking at what materials would make a good insulator, keeping hot water hot. We have been experimenting with different materials and covering plastic cups with insulation using materials like tin foil, wood, paper, cotton wool and plastic. The children have been recording temperatures at the start of the experiment and see how much temperature has been lost over the time.

The children have been looking at symmetry and shapes when creating their designs.


Phonics
