Phonics

Our sounds this week were: ay, ai, a-e and we introduced 'ey' as in grey and 'a' as in bacon

Our words this week were: for, could, called, that, to

Our words of the week for next week are: put, the, help, by, now

English... This week we have written letters to the Foolhardy Circus and asked them lots of questions so we could find out lots of different information. We have distinguished the differences between a statement and a question and looked at question starter words such as 'do, will, can and where'. We've also worked hard to use a question mark at the end of our questions.



History... This week we have introduced out overarching theme of The Circus and dived straight into comparing the circus from the past to now. The children noticed that we no longer have animals in the circuses today and photos of past circuses were in black and white. We have learnt about a significant person called Philip Astley and have placed different circuses onto a timeline.

Science... This week we have introduced our planting topic and planted some beans in our digging beds. We have started to collect data of the weather and temperature so we can make sure the beans are looked after and grow. We discussed how to take care of them and the children have been watering them and checking on them daily. We have planted 1 bean in a cup and popped it in the cupboard to see if it will grow without sunlight. The children have made some super predictions that we will revisit soon!



Maths... This week we have revisited partitioning and reminded ourselves what we need to do to be successful. It was lovely to see the children remembered so much from our previous learning and they had a fantastic go at Math's challenges. We answered true and false questions, partitioned numbers within 100 and also solved partitioning problems with our rainbow brains.
