Tues 6<sup>th</sup> Sept-School re-opens-Diamond class CLOSED as doing Home Visits for new children

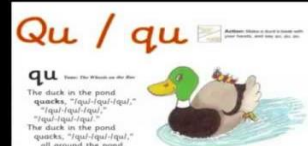
Mon 12<sup>th</sup> September – Diamonds re-open
