

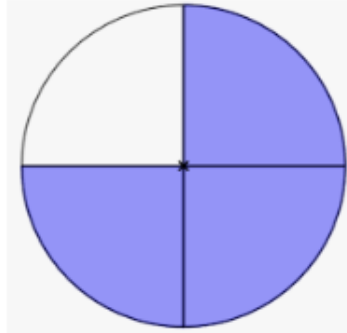


Year 2 - WB 3.5.22



English

We had such a great time last week when the Foolhardy circus came to visit, so this week we have written a thank you letter to Cosmo! The children have used adjectives and adverbs to describe their experience and have used conjunctions to add extra detail. Lots of the children challenged themselves to go beyond the conjunctions and, so, and because and used trickier ones like if, when, which and or.



Maths

This week we have looked at fractions where the numerator (top number) is greater than 1, e.g. $\frac{3}{4}$. The children shaded different quarters and thirds of shapes, and found missing numbers in fractions involving amounts. They really impressed us as lots of the children got to the tricky red challenge!

Science

This week we have continued to look at life cycles. However this week we looked at animals that go through a metamorphosis during their life cycle, for example a caterpillar changes into a chrysalis, then a butterfly during its life cycle. We compared the life cycles of animals that get bigger, and those that go through metamorphosis.



Art

We have been collaging in our art lessons. This week we thought about complementary colour using the colour wheel. We looked at the snail by Henri Matisse and noticed he had used lots of complementary colours. We decided to create our own collage of a circus act using these colours.

Phonics

This week we have looked at the digraphs wr, gn, and kn.
