Tues 6th Sept-School re-opens-Diamond class CLOSED as doing Home Visits for new children

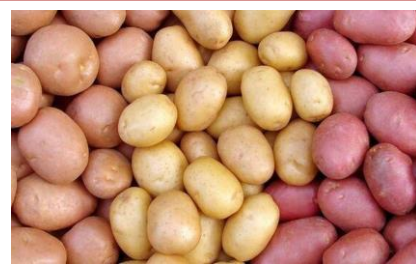
Mon 12th September – Diamonds re-open

Suncream and sunhats
