


Year 2 - WB 19.9.22




Maths

In Maths this week we have used our place value knowledge to compare numbers using the symbols for greater than (>) and less than (<). The children know to look at the number of tens in each number, and that the symbol will need to face the number with the most tens or the most ones if the tens are the same.


Science

In our science this week we took a look at different habitats. The children discuss what a habitat is and sorted out animals into their different habitats. We also discusses why an animal would live in that habitat.



Geography and art
