Phonics

Maths

In maths this week we revisited comparing quantities and numbers using the <> = symbols. We applied our place value knowledge from last week to work with numbers to 30 and have worked on different true or false and word problems linked to this.

PE

This half term in PE we are focusing on dance. We started off by thinking about different types of weather and trying out movements linked to these. We have also been practising listening to and trying to keep to the beat of the music. We have explored different pathways to include in our dances and have worked with a partner to make up our own weather dances using all of the skills and movements that we have practised as a class.

Philosophy

In philosophy this week we explored the idea of whether there is such a thing as 'boys' or 'girls' toys and whether certain colours should be just for boys or girls as well. This created a lot of discussion around likes and dislikes and how everyone has different likes and interests regardless of their gender.



English

In English this week we have continued with our work on deforestation and have made posters to tell people to save the rainforest, with a focus on persuading the reader.
