
### **Phonics**


This week we have focused on the sounds: **ur**, **ow**, **oi**, **er**

#### Maths

In maths this week we have been focusing on place value up to 30 and partitioning these numbers. This means we have been breaking the number up and seeing what it is made of. We have used a part, part whole model to support our learning. When partitioning the number we broke it up into seeing how many tens it has and how many ones.





### English

In English this week we continued to focus on super sentence writing. We wrote sentences about our half term. For this writing we spoke about to make it successful we need to write in first person (I, my) and make sure we wrote in past tense. Our challenge with our writing this week was to write about our opinion or how it made us feel.

#### Science

In Science this term we are focusing on planting. This week we started off our learning by identifying the key parts that make up a flower and then identifying the needs of a flower to keep it alive. Both classes have also started their own experiment of putting a bulb into a cupboard and one in sunlight to see what happens, we will keep checking on this over the next few weeks.

This week in History we learnt about Edith Cavell and why she is significant. We discussed what we thought about Edith Cavell and a lot of the children spoke about how she was brave, kind and how helpful she was.
