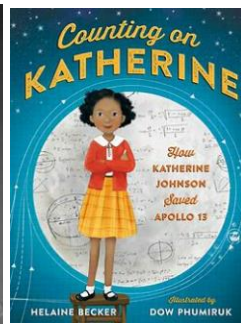


## English

This week in English we have been writing a diary entry from the perspective of Katherine Johnson.

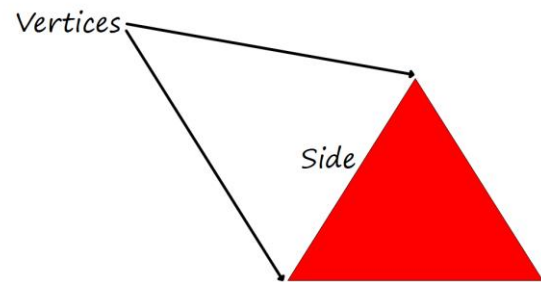
Katherine Johnson loved math. Early in her career, she was called a "computer." She helped NASA put an astronaut into orbit around Earth.

## Maths

Vertices are another word for 'corners'. The children have been using sentence stems to prove they know what a shape is called. For example:  
I know this shape is a triangle because it has 3 sides and 3 vertices.

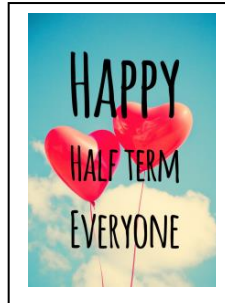
