



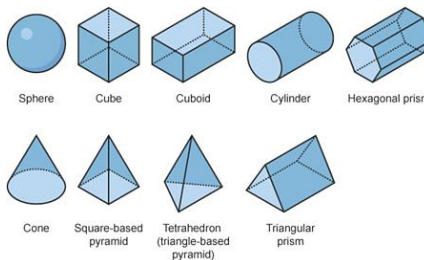
Year 2 - WB 20.2.23

Maths

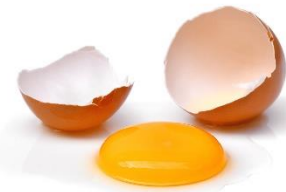
