

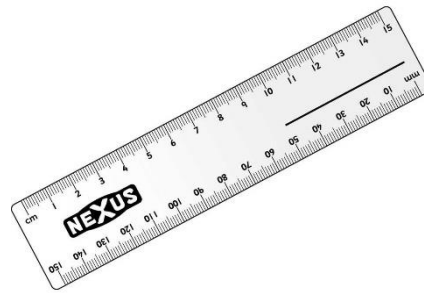
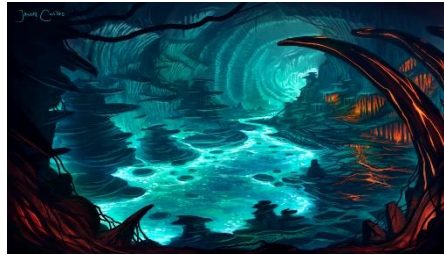


# Year 2 - WB 6.3.23

## Science

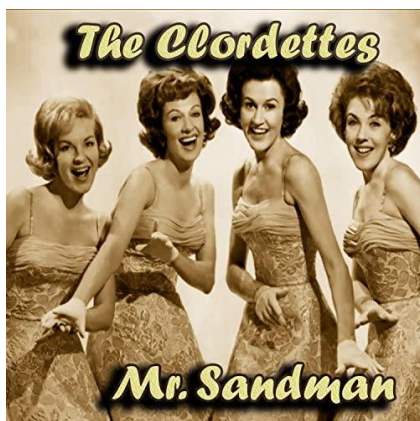
