No Nuts Policy

We have some children in school who suffer from severe nut allergies, please could we take this opportunity to remind everyone that our school endeavours to have a "No Nuts Policy". This means that the following items should not be brought into school:

- Packs of nuts
- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Nutella/ chocolate and nut spread sandwiches
- Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts ie tracker bars
- Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
- Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
- Pesto
- Cakes made with nuts

We do not use nuts in any of our food prepared on site at our school.

If there are any issues that you feel arise as a result of this policy, please do feel free to come and see me to discuss them and if your child develops any allergies, please inform the school.
