

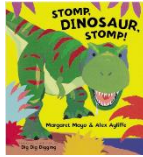
Year Two News

Spellings

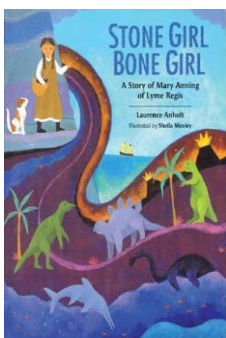
This week's spellings are: find, told, nice, magic, does, goes, call, tall, small. You can find them on our 15th September Tapestry post.
