#### **Phonics**

In phonics we have moved on to Basics 4 and this week looked at CVCC (consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant) words e.g. melt, hand, gift. Jazzy Jack and Magic Mack helped us to say the harder to hear sounds in those words 'a little bit louder and a little bit longer.'

We thought about all of the usual things that we need to include in a sentence and used numbers to start our instructions too. Some children challenged themselves to use 'and' or 'because' in their instructions.

The children loved looking at different maps and then making their own 'messy maps' of the classroom using different 3D objects. They showed great teamwork as well!
