Art

In art this week we began to explore different techniques that we can use when working with clay. We also used natural materials to make imprints.





English

In English this week, we thought about our trip to the dino park last week and wrote a simple recount of some of the things that we did. We tried to remember to use the past tense and write in the correct order, as well as using our finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. Some children challenged themselves to add adjectives too.

Science

This week we started off our animals topic by drawing and labelling our favourite animals and thinking about which animals we would and wouldn't find in Sparhawk Park and why.

History
