Phonics

We have moved onto recapping Year 1 Spelling rules. This week we have been looking at adding s and es to make words plurals. Ask the children about fizzy sounds – s ss z zz x ch sh & tch

Maths

This week we have been looking at adding 2 two-digit numbers together using tens and ones to help us.

The children have been learning how to exchange ten ones for a ten to help them bridge through a ten. E.g. 27 + 27 = 20 + 20 = 40 7 + 7 = 14 40 + 10 = 50 50 + 4 = 54

Home learning opportunity:

Find household items to represent tens and ones. For example you could use pasta shapes – spaghetti could equal tens and penne could equal ones. Can the children solve two-digit addition problems such 24 + 34 = using them.

Or can they bridge through a ten and exchange – 28 + 38 =
