

This week we have started writing a story using the book Lima's red hot chilli. We changed the story to make it our own by changing Lima to our very character that we designed a couple of weeks ago. The children have been looking at what makes a story successful, and thinking about the different parts of the story using the story mountain. This week we wrote the beginning and the build up to the story.

Phonics

We have moved onto recapping Year 1 Spelling rules. This week we have been looking at adding the suffix ing to a root word where there is no change needed. For example jump becomes jumping.

Maths

This week we have been looking at taking away 2 two-digit numbers together using tens and ones to help us.

The children have been learning how to exchange one ten for ten ones to help them bridge through a ten. E.g. 54 – 26 =

50-20=30 You cannot do 4-6 so swap a ten for 10 ones. Take the ten from our 30.

30 - 10 = 20

14 - 6 = 8

20 + **8**= 28

54 - 26 = 28

Home learning opportunity:

Find household items to represent tens and ones. For example, you could use pasta shapes – spaghetti could equal tens and penne could equal ones. Can the children solve two-digit subtraction problems such 54 - 22 = using them. Or can they bridge through a ten and exchange – 65 - 37 =
