### DROPPING OFF AND PICKING UP

Thank you for your patience and understanding in this first week where there are lots of new things for us all to learn-the process can take a little time especially at the start of the year.

At pick up we try to get the children ready in the order of the queue which can be tricky at times-please try to let us see your faces! Please allow parent/carers with upset children to go first.

If anyone new is picking up please let us know in the morning or via the school office – a password can be set if it is someone new or if they have not picked up for a long while.

## TAPESTRY ONLINE LEARNING JOURNEY

- 2. Posting class activities relevant to learning this may involve whole class times that your child has been part of(even if they are not in any photos) to help to give you a flavor of what we have been doing and could provide a talking point at home.
- 3.Offering an Autumn and Spring term parents meeting and either a Summer term 'report'or another meeting(TBC)
- 4. Informal chats requested by you or us to support the learning while your child is in Nursery.
