

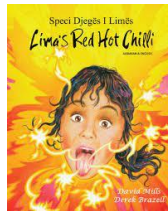
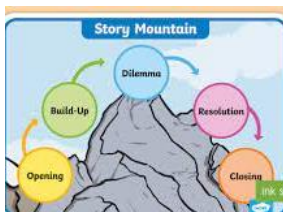
Year Two News

English

This week we have continued writing a story using the book Lima's red hot chilli. We changed the story to make it our own by changing Lima to our very character that we designed a couple of weeks ago. The children have been looking at what makes a story successful and thinking about the different parts of the story using the story mountain. This week we finished our stories with a solution and an ending.



Phonics

We have moved onto recapping Year 1 Spelling rules. This week we have been looking at adding the suffix ed to a root word where there is no change needed. For example jump becomes jumped.



Maths

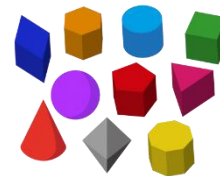
This week we have been looking at addition and subtraction problems. The children have been learning about equal calculations e.g. $23 + 7 = 34 - 4$

We have also been finding missing numbers within these calculations e.g. $34 - __ = 23 + 7$

Perhaps your children could go on a shape hunt around the house, garden or neighbourhood. What 2D or 3D shapes can they find. This will help them label shapes next week.
