

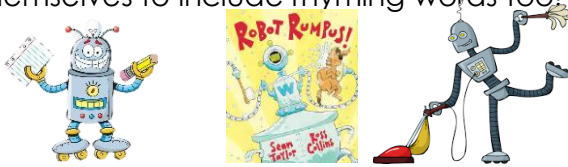
Year Two News

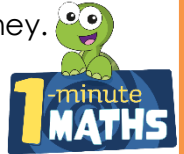


Phonics
