English

This week in English we have written a Spring themed poem. We discussed how in a couple of weeks it will be Spring and that we are already able to notice in our environment signs of spring. To make our writing successful this week we learnt about a noun phrase for example: the beautiful daffodils are growing. We also challenged ourselves to include a simile (the clouds are as fluffy as cotton wool) or alliteration (beautiful blue birds).

Phonics

This week we have been looking at suffixes again but this time we have been changing the y to an i and adding est. For example: funny → funniest & hungry → hungriest. This rule happens when we are comparing something to be more than the other. For example: Miss Whitlam is funny but Mr Ainley is the funniest. We had a go at using this within our Spring poems this week.

Maths

This week we have recapped our knowledge of multiplication and division. The children have been looking at the 2, 5 and 10 times table. We did a lot of consolidation over our learning from the past few weeks and next week we will be moving onto fractions.
