## **Phonics**

This week we have been looking at suffixes again but this time we have been changing verbs to the past tense by dropping the e and adding ed. For example: shape → shaped & care → cared. We drop the 'e' because 'd' is not a suffix on its own.

The children cared for the puppies and baked some cookies.

### Maths

This week we have recapped our knowledge of fractions from Year One. The children have been learning about halves and how to write fractions using numerators (parts) and denominators (whole). We have begun looking at quarters too, which we will continue next week.
