Maths

This week we have been learning about doubles using the sentence stem e.g. 2 is a part, 2 is a part then this is a double which equals 4. We have used 2 die to model this and our fingers to match the 2 parts that make a double. We have also used butterfly wings to explore this as each wing is the same so the patterns are a double.
