English

Geography

Phonics

Maths

This week we have begun learning to tell the time. The children had fantastic knowledge of o'clock and half past from Year 1. We have consolidated that and moved onto quarter past and quarter to. The children have been learning about how clocks move with the hour and minute hands too.

1 Minute Maths

Science

The children have been learning about what plants need to survive: water, sunlight and good soil. We looked at different plants, seeds and bulbs and how they are structured to use the water, sunlight and soil.

Art

Within our art lessons, we have begun looking at drawing self-portraits. We looked at a Kenyan artist called Thandiwe Muriu, who uses self-portraits within her unique art style. The children have been responding to her artwork this week, critiquing it, comparing it and loving it.
