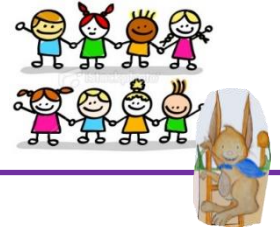


Year Two News



Friday 17th May



English

This week in English we have finished writing our own story, focusing on the resolution and ending.

We have looked at how to make a sentence more interesting with sentence openers and thought about including different conjunctions.

Design and Technology

This week we cooked chapatis and samosas. We discussed how to cook safely and all the children had a go at parts of the making of the food. The children then had the opportunity to try the food- take a look on Tapestry for any photos and videos 😊

Science

This week in Science we took a look at our flower beds and looked at how our flowers were doing after the temperature experiment we started two weeks ago. We were surprised to see that the flowers growing indoors are doing a lot better than outside! We then discussed how sunlight can help plants to grow. We carried out another experiment where we planted some more seeds and then placed one near a window with sunlight and the other in a cupboard without/ with very little light. We will continue to observe the growth and draw conclusions at the end.

Warm Weather

There are some suncreams that last all day, or you can send your child in with sun cream (please make sure it is named) which they can reapply during the day. Please be aware that we are not able to put the sun cream on the children but we do have mirrors they can use.

This week we have been looking at suffixes again but this time looking at doubling the consonant and adding y. For example snap → snappy.

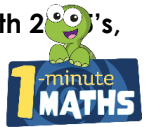
Maths

This week we have continued our learning with height and length. We have looked at the four operations (+, -, x, ÷) and solved worded problems using one of the operations.

1 Minute Maths

You could look at any of the magic mix's within the addition and subtraction folders.

You could also recap over multiplication with 2's, 10's and dividing by 2's, 5's, 10's.
