For the last few weeks of term, we are revisiting the Basics 3 sounds and focusing on blending and segmenting with these sounds.

We have been comparing groups of the same object with a big difference in number, and then a small difference. We've been comparing by looking, then by matching 1-to-1. We've explored groups that have an equal amount and compared groups of objects that are different sizes, colours and attributes. The children have also been developing a sense of magnitude,e.g. knowing that 8 is a lot more than 2, but that 4 is only a little bit more than 2.
